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ACUTE PARTIAL HOSPITALIZATION PROGRAM

Haven's Acute Partial Hospitalization Program is part of our continuum of recovery focused care. The Partial Program helps individuals safely manage their psychiatric problems on an intensive outpatient basis and resolve acute psychiatric symptoms within a safe and supportive treatment setting.

Individuals are closely supervised in a structured setting while remaining in the community among friends, family and support systems. Our staff is prepared to work with individuals who are in the process of recovering from an acute psychiatric illness. Individuals may

require close monitoring for medication compliance, or a diversion from inpatient treatment.

Individuals receive programming tailored to meet their treatment needs. The program goal is to reflect and replicate life in the greater community, emphasizing therapeutic intervention with staff and peers to facilitate change.

The program operates five days a week from Monday through Friday from 9:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. The average length of stay is approximately two to three weeks. Discharge is determined in collaboration with the individual, family, treatment team and physician.



CLINICAL SERVICES

Individuals actively participate in supervised recovery focused treatment for five hours per day, Monday through Friday. The treatment team provides support, structure and a safe therapeutic environment. Individuals participate in group and family therapy and meet with the psychiatrist on a regular basis. Group therapy includes cognitive and emotional processing, coping strategies and goal-oriented treatment interventions. Transportation is provided for individuals within commuting distances of our facility.

INTERDISCIPLINARY TREATMENT TEAM

Haven has a team of highly trained and experienced behavioral health professionals who work with the individual, their family, community providers and others to develop a treatment and discharge plan. The core members of the partial program include master level therapists, program director, social worker, nurse and psychiatrist.

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
